*For the purposes of this sub-title, all of the money expended by the Department of Correction to maintain the penal system based on a cost per man per day shall be considered the cost of board and maintenance of a prisoner.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1955.*

CHAPTER 430

(Senate Bill 195)

AN ACT to repeal Sub-section (b) of Section 9 of Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments", sub-title "General Provisions", relating to the printing for distribution by the Secretary of State of certain rules of the Executive Branch.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sub-section (b) of Section 9 of Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments", sub-title "General Provisions", be and it is hereby repealed.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1955.*

CHAPTER 431

(Senate Bill 227)

AN ACT to add new Sub-section 15(3)(f) to Article 101 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Workmen's Compensation", sub-title "Suit—Methods of Insurance", said new sub-section to follow immediately after Sub-section 15(3)(e) thereof, relating to the return of securities deposited by self-insurers under the Workmen's Compensation Laws.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That new Sub-section 15(3)(f) be and it is hereby added to Article 101 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title*
