A Bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 67 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore County (1955 Edition), being Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Baltimore County', said section being in 'Title 4, County Commissioners' and being under the sub-heading 'Borrowing Power', relating to the power of Baltimore County to borrow money and incur indebtedness and to the amount of such indebtedness in relation to the assessed value of all real and personal property subject to assessment for unlimited taxation by said County."
