

Acts repealed.

SEC. 14. *And be it enacted*, That the act of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at its session in the year eighteen hundred and eleven, chapter one hundred and sixty-two, entitled "a further additional supplement to an act entitled an act for the relief of the poor of Frederick county," the act passed by the General Assembly of Maryland at its session in the year eighteen hundred and seventeen, chapter one hundred and three, entitled "an act to authorise the Levy Court of Frederick county to increase the pay of the overseer of the poor in said county," the third and fourth sections of an act passed by the General Assembly of Maryland at its session in the year eighteen hundred and twenty-eight, chapter one hundred and fifty-two, entitled "a supplement to an act entitled an act to authorise the Levy Court of Frederick county to levy a sum of money to purchase a tract of land and build a house thereon for the use of the paupers, and sell the present Poor House of said county, and for other purposes," and the act passed by the General Assembly of Maryland at its session in the year eighteen hundred and forty-three, chapter two hundred and forty-three, entitled "an act to increase the bond of the keeper of the Almshouse for Frederick county," be and the same are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 97.

Passed Mar. 6, 1856. AN ACT to establish and endow an Agricultural College in the State of Maryland.

Preamble. WHEREAS, it hath been represented to the Legislature, that certain wise and virtuous citizens, are desirous of instituting and establishing in some convenient locality within this State, an Agricultural College, and Model Farm, in which the youthful student may especially be instructed, in those arts and sciences indispensable, to successful Agricultural pursuits, *and whereas*, it doth appear to this Legislature, that while the wise and learned in the present age have cultivated with
