CHAPTER 335.

Passed March 9, 1858. AN ACT to amend the act to incorporate the New Cut Turnpike Road Company, passed at the session of eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, and to supply an omission in said act.

Authorised to extend road. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the New Cut Turnpike Road Company, in Baltimore county, shall have power and are hereby authorised to extend said turnpike road from the Rolling road to the Liberty road.
