

Dec. Sess. 1813. *Clar*, before he derives any benefit from or under this act, shall lodge his collection books in the clerk's office of Calvert county, to be opened for the inspection of all persons interested in the same.

CHAPTER 180.

Passed Jan. 31, 1814. *An act for the relief of Isaac Baker of Calvert county.*
Sum to be levied for his maintenance. Section 1. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the justices of the levy court of Calvert county be, and they are hereby empowered and directed at their levy court annually, to assess and levy a sum of money not exceeding thirty dollars, on the assessable property of said county, for the support and maintenance of Isaac Baker, to be collected as other county charges are, and paid to the said Isaac Baker or his order.

CHAPTER 181.

Passed Jan. 31, 1814. *An act authorising Benjamin Leach, late collector of Calvert county, to complete his collection.*

Preamble. WHEREAS it is represented to this General Assembly, by the petition of Benjamin Leach late collector of Calvert county, that from various causes therein set forth, he has not been able to complete his collection within the time limited, and that there is still due to him as collector of said county considerable sums of money, and praying that a law may pass to enable him to collect the same; *Therefore,*

Time for collection extended. Section 1. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the said Benjamin Leach be, and he is hereby authorised to collect until the first day of January eighteen hundred and fifteen, all balances due him as collector of Calvert county for the year eighteen hundred and twelve, in the same manner as he could or might have done within the time limited by law, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

Distress. 2. AND BE IT ENACTED, That it shall be the duty of the said Benjamin Leach, before he proceeds to execute or distrain the property of any person or persons for taxes or public dues in virtue of this act, to deliver to such person or persons, chargeable with the same at least thirty days previous to levying such execution or distress, an account written in words at full length, of the taxes demanded of him, her or them, with an affidavit annexed if required, that he hath not received any part thereof, nor any thing as security or satisfaction for the same, more than credit given, to the best of his knowledge.

Collection books. 3. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the said Benjamin Leach, before he derives any benefit from or under this act, shall lodge his collection books in the clerk's office of Calvert county, to be opened for the inspection of all persons interested in the same.
