House Joint Resolution expressing deepest regrets over the passing of the Honorable Frank M. Schuler of Baltimore County.

WHEREAS, The Members of the General Assembly of Maryland have learned with the deepest regret of the passing of the Honorable Frank M. Schuler of Baltimore County; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Schuler has long been identified with the public life of his county, having served in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Baltimore County, as a member of the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Baltimore County, and more recently as secretary to the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, He was a kind, considerate and affable man, a devoted husband and beloved by all his friends and associates; and
