GOVERNOR'S PROCLAMATION DECLARING THE RESULT OF THE  
ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 6, 1956, FOR REFERENDUM

WHEREAS, Under authority contained in Article 16 of the Constitution of Maryland, the Secretary of State was legally and duly petitioned by the qualified voters of Talbot County, Maryland, to submit to the qualified voters of said County for their adoption or rejection at the election to be held on November 6, 1956, Chapter 403 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1955; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State, acting under the authority contained in said Article 16 of the Constitution of the State, did at said election of November 6, 1956, so submit the said Act to the qualified voters of Talbot County, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, from the returns of said election transmitted to me as required by the provisions of Article 16 of the Constitution it appears that:

For adoption of Chapter 403 aforesaid, 2,265 votes were cast and against the adoption thereof, 2,247 votes were cast in said county

NOW, THEREFORE, I, THEODORE R. MCKELDIN, GOVERNOR OF MARYLAND, do by this my Proclamation issued under the authority and direction contained in said Article 16 of the Constitution, hereby declare and proclaim that in Talbot County, Maryland, a majority of the votes having been cast for the adoption of the said referred law, Chapter 403 of the Acts of 1955, the same has been adopted and, therefore, under the provisions of Article 16 of the Constitution, has been ratified by a majority of the qualified voters of Talbot County.
