(j) *In St. Mary's County, there shall be a special Class D (On Sale) beer license which shall be issued to any bona fide religious, fraternal, civic, veterans', hospital or charitable organization, for a period not exceeding ten consecutive days from the effective date thereof, upon the payment of a fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each such license.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect on June 1, 1957.*

CHAPTER 546

(House Bill 237)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 217L of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "St. Mary's County", sub-title "Trailers", said section having been enacted by Chapter 580 of the Acts of 1949 and repealed by Chapter 747 of the Acts of 1953 with a new Section 217L being enacted in lieu thereof, providing for the illegal parking of trailers in St. Mary's County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 217L of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "St. Mary's County", sub-title "Trailers", said section having been enacted by Chapter 580 of the Acts of 1949 and repealed by Chapter 747 of the Acts of 1953 with a new Section 217L being enacted in lieu thereof, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:*

217L. (Prohibited Parking.) It shall be unlawful for any person to maintain [or], use *or park* any trailer coach which is occupied for dwelling or sleeping purposes, *or is unoccupied* any place within St. Mary's County for a period of ~~not~~ more than ~~ten~~ THIRTY days in any ~~month~~ CALENDAR YEAR except in a duly licensed trailer park or upon obtaining written permission from the Department of Health.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1957.*
