

Amendment No. 5—In line 6 of Section 14 on page 3 of the printed bill, strike out the word “three” and insert in lieu thereof the word “five”.

Amendment No. 6—In line 50 of Section 14 on page 3 of the printed bill, strike out the word “shall” and insert in lieu thereof the following: “by majority vote may”.

Amendment No. 7—Following line 27 of Section 15 on page 4 of the printed bill, insert the following new section: “16. Nothing in this sub-title shall apply to or within the limits of Anne Arundel, Calvert, Caroline, Carroll, Cecil, Dorchester, Harford, Howard, Kent, Queen Anne’s, St. Mary’s, Somerset, Talbot, Wicomico, and Worcester Counties”.

Amendments offered from the floor by Mr. Acker:

Amendment No. 1—In line 1 of the title and in line 2 of Section 1 on page 1 of the printed bill, strike out in each instance the word “and” and insert in lieu thereof a comma, and in the same lines after the numerals “15” add the following: “and 16”.
