## CHAPTER 26

(House Bill 20)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 8-1 to 8-18, inclusive, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Anne Arundel County (1957 Edition, being Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Anne Arundel County", sub-title "Chapter 8. Electrical Installations", and to enact new Sections 8-1 to 8-34, inclusive, in lieu thereof, to stand in the place of the sections repealed, to revise the laws licensing and regulating electricians in Anne Arundel County, to establish a Board of Electrical Examiners and Supervisors for the county, and to provide its powers and duties, and relating to electricians in Anne Arundel County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 8-1 to 8-18, inclusive, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Anne Arundel County (1957 Edition, being Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Anne Arundel County", sub-title "Chapter 8. Electrical Installations", be and they are hereby repealed, and that new Sections 8-1 to 8-34, inclusive, in lieu thereof, to stand in the place of the section repealed, be and they are hereby enacted, to read as follows:

### 8-1.

*The Governor shall, within thirty days after June 1, 1962, appoint a Board to be known as the Board of Electrical Examiners and Supervisors for Anne Arundel County, and the members of such Board shall be three Master Electricians licensed in and residents of Anne Arundel County. Appointments to such Board shall be for terms of four years, except that those members appointed after June 1, 1962, shall serve only through the balance of the term in office of the present Governor. Should any vacancy occur from any cause during the term of any Board member, the Governor shall appoint a qualified successor to complete the unexpired balance of such term. Upon the presentation of satisfactory evidence in open hearing, the Governor shall have full power to remove any member of the Board for reasons of incompetence or improper conduct.*
