**Senate Bill No. 35—Testamentary Disposition of Motor Vehicles**

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 260 of Article 93 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1961 Supplement), title "Testamentary Law", sub-title "Orphans' Court", amending the law concerning the testamentary disposition of certain motor vehicles in order to provide therein that no inheritance tax shall be collected on such motor vehicles.
