"Section 1A. And be it further enacted, That new Section 220 be and it is hereby added to Article 25 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1961 Supplement), to follow immediately after Section 219 thereof and to be under the new subtitle 'New Counties', and to read as follows:

220. The Board of County Commissioners or County Council of every county in this State may form new counties. In so doing, there shall follow the applicable provisions of Section 1 of Article 13 of the Constitution of Maryland. As to any provisions or procedure for forming new counties which are not prescribed or referred to in said Section 1 of Article 13 of the Constitution, the Board of County Commissioners or County Council may establish provisions and regulations applying to the formation of a new county or counties. The provisions of this section specifically include authority by two or more counties to set up a new county or counties composed of portions of two or more counties."
