

## C H A P. CV.

Passed January 20.

A Further supplement to the act, entitled, An act to lay out several turnpike roads in Baltimore county, and for other purposes.

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS the commissioners of review for Baltimore county have not, in conformity to the powers vested in them by an act of the last general assembly, entitled, A further supplement to the act, entitled, An act to lay out several turnpike roads in Baltimore county, and for other purposes, within the time therein limited, reviewed and ultimately ascertained the direction of the several turnpike roads mentioned in said further supplement; therefore,

Time extended, &amp;c.

II. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the time limited in the said further supplement, passed at the last session of assembly, for ascertaining and fixing the direction of the turnpike roads therein mentioned, be and the same is hereby extended to the first Monday in October next.

Commissioners to call on the collectors, &amp;c.

III. *And be it enacted,* That the commissioners of review, or a majority of them, shall have power and authority to call on any person or persons who have or may hereafter be appointed collector or collectors of the tax imposed on Baltimore county by the original act to which this is a further supplement, to settle and pay the amount of said tax, agreeably to the directions of the said original act, and in case of refusal or neglect to settle and pay the same within the time directed by law for payment of the county levies, the commissioners of review, or a majority of them, shall proceed against the said collector or collectors, and their securities, in the same manner as the justices of the peace are directed by the act for the establishment and regulation of the levy courts in the several counties in this state are directed to proceed against collectors, and their securities, and there shall be similar proceedings, and similar remedy, for the recovery of the same.

## C H A P. CVI.

Passed January 20.

An ACT to pay the civil list, and other expences of civil government.

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS those who dedicate their time, abilities and labour, to the public, ought to receive a reasonable and adequate compensation for their services,

Officers salaries.

II. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following officers of civil government for the time being shall be entitled to receive at the rate of the following salaries in current money for the ensuing year, to wit: The treasurer of the western shore, two thousand dollars; the treasurer of the eastern shore, four hundred and fifty dollars; the auditor, eight hundred dollars; the clerk of the council, seven hundred dollars; the clerk of the senate, one hundred and fifty dollars; the clerk of the house of delegates, three hundred dollars; the printer to the state, fourteen hundred dollars; the messenger to the council, two hundred and fifty dollars.

Monies to be first applied.

III. *And be it enacted,* That all monies which shall remain in the treasury, after discharging the journal of accounts, and all monies heretofore appropriated to the use of congress, which shall hereafter be received, and all unappropriated money which may come into the treasury, be first applied to the payment of the civil list for the ensuing year.

## C H A P. CVII.

Passed January 20.

An ACT to increase the fees of the examiner-general of the western shore, and the examiner of the eastern shore.

Fees increased.

**B**e it enacted, *by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That immediately after the passing of this act the fees of the examiner-general of the western shore shall be and they are hereby increased thirty-three and a third *per cent.* in addition to his fees already allowed by law.
