SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 290-301 inclusive of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Dorchester County", sub-title "Fences", be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

CHAPTER 34

(Senate Bill 51)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 339-343, inclusive, of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Dorchester County", sub-title "Jurors", repealing certain unnecessary and duplicating local laws of Dorchester County concerning the procedure for selecting jurors.

WHEREAS, In the local laws of Dorchester County are a number of sections which specify the procedure for selecting jurors; and

WHEREAS, This subject is amply covered in the general laws of the State so that the local laws are unnecessary; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 339-343, inclusive, of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Dorchester County", sub-title "Jurors", be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.
