

CHAPTER 336

(Senate Bill 415)

AN ACT to add a new Section 73 (c) to Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1960 Supplement), title "Elections", sub-title "Vacancies In ~~Nominations~~ NOMINATION In General", to follow immediately after Section 73 (b) thereof, providing in Baltimore City that the Board of Supervisors of Elections after the final time for declining a nomination or withdrawing as a candidate, shall post in a public place a notice which gives a complete list of the remaining nominees or candidates.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 73 (c) be and it is hereby added to Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1960 Supplement), title "Elections", sub-title "Vacancies In ~~Nominations~~ NOMINATION In General", to follow immediately after Section 73 (b) thereof, and to read as follows:

73.

(c) In Baltimore City, within one hour following the final time for declining a nomination or withdrawing as a candidate, under the provisions of this section, the board of supervisors of elections shall post in a public place a notice which gives a complete list of the remaining nominees or candidates for each office in the coming general, primary or special election.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

CHAPTER 337

(Senate Bill 416)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 4 (b) of Article 2C of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1960 Supplement), title "Alcoholism", and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 2 of Chapter 37 of the Acts of 1960, to change the time for a report to be submitted by the Maryland Commission on Alcoholism, and to impose a limit on its appropriations for a certain year.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 4 (b) of Article 2C of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1960 Supplement), title "Alcoholism", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, and that Section 2 of Chapter 37 of the Acts of 1960, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, both to read as follows:
