

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 715A(h) of Article 66C of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1960 Supplement), title "Natural Resources", sub-title "Oysters and Clams", be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

CHAPTER 563

(House Bill 696)

AN ACT to add a new Section 79A to the Code of Public Local Laws of Garrett County (1957 Edition, being Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Garrett County", sub-title "County Commissioners," to follow immediately after Section 79 thereof, providing that the County Commissioners of Garrett County shall make supplementary payments to certain retired public school teachers in Garrett County and relating generally to the terms and conditions of such payments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new Section 79A be and it is hereby added to the Code of Public Local Laws of Garrett County (1957 Edition, being Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Garrett County", sub-title "County Commissioners", to follow immediately after Section 79 thereof, and to read as follows:

79A. The County Commissioners of Garrett County shall make a supplementary payment monthly to any retired public school teacher in Garrett County who (1) taught twenty years or more PRIOR TO THE YEAR 1928 in the public school system of Garrett County and (2) is receiving less than one hundred dollars (\$100) each month from any retirement system operated by the State of Maryland for public school teachers in such amount as necessary from time to time to make the retirement payment plus the payment under this section equal to the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100).

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.
