

(1957 Edition), title "Crimes and Punishments", sub-title "Sabbath Breaking", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

524.

Nothing contained in Sections 492 or 522 of this article shall be construed to prohibit or make unlawful the operation within the boundaries of Carroll County of any bowling alley, tenpin alley or duckpin alley between the hours of [1] 2 P.M. and [6] ~~11:30~~ P.M. on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, with or without a charge or fee, provided, however, that no organized or league game may be played in said alleys at any time on said day. Any operation of bowling alleys, tenpin alleys or duckpin alleys on Sunday, except as hereby authorized shall be unlawful and subject to the provisions and penalties of Sections 492 or 522 of this article.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

CHAPTER 579

(House Bill 862)

AN ACT to authorize the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's County to provide for the publication of a Code of Public Local Laws of St. Mary's County, being Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, and in the discretion of the county commissioners, of certain ordinances and/or resolutions of the county commissioners, relating to the provisions for such publication and providing that the Code, if published, shall be evidence of certain laws.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's County is authorized to provide for the publication of the Code of Public Local Laws of St. Mary's County, being Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland. The board is authorized to make the necessary appropriations to defray the costs of publication and it further is authorized to provide for the sale and distribution of the Code.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That if the said Code is published, it is hereby legalized. It shall contain all Public Local Laws relating to St. Mary's County in effect after the last regular session of the General Assembly of Maryland, prior to the publication of said Code, and it shall contain the Charters of the several municipal corporations within St. Mary's County. In the discretion of the county commissioners, it may also contain a Code of the ordinances and/or resolu-
