SUBJECT: MOTOR VEHICLES.

Amendment proposed by Mr. Norris: "On page 2, line 16, after the word 'highways,' insert 'other than reasonable regulations and charges for parking purposes, where such incorporated town or city provides special parking places or facilities.'" [Which amendment was withdrawn.]

Amendment proposed by Mr. Ogden: "Amend amendment by inserting the word 'voluntary' before the word 'parking.'" [Which was rejected.]

Amendment proposed by the President: "Amend by inserting after the word 'highways,' on page 2, line 16, the following words: 'other than reasonable charges for the parking of vehicles within spaces set aside exclusively for parking purposes in congested sections.'" Which was read and adopted by yeas and nays as follows:

Amendment proposed by the President: "Amend by inserting after the words 'reasonable traffic regulations,' line 13, and before the words 'applicable to all,' line 13, the following words: 'by fine or imprisonment, either or both in the discretion of the court.'" [Which was read and adopted.]

Amendment proposed by Mr. Warfield: "Amend by inserting between lines 78 and 79 of Section 141, 'Fees for Registration of Motor Vehicles,' page 13, the following:

'Class F.—One dollar (\$1.00) per horse-power or fraction thereof in the case of all motor vehicles operating for the purpose of transporting persons for hire upon any of the pub-
