Also House Bill No. 608, entitled “An Act to require the guard boat for Herring Bay to be kept on duty all the year, as other boats of the regular Oyster Navy are kept on duty.” [*Endorsed: “Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays.”*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Chesapeake Bay and Tributaries.*]

Also House Bill No. 734, entitled “An Act to repeal Section 3 of the Acts of 1914, Chapter 800, relating to the salaries of members of the State Industrial Accident Commission, and to re-enact the same, with amendments.” [*Endorsed: “Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays.”*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

Also House Bill No. 732, entitled “An Act to add a new section to Article 23 of Bagby’s Annotated Code of Maryland, title ‘Corporations,’ sub-title ‘Public Service Commission,’ to follow Section 414 and to be designated Section 414-A.” [*Endorsed: “Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays.”*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

Also House Bill No. 793, entitled “An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 12 of Chapter 652 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1894, entitled ‘An Act to incorporate the town of Burkittsville, in Frederick county.’” [*Endorsed: “Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays.”*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Kaufman, Bomberger and Warfield.*]

Also House Bill No. 817, entitled “An Act to add additional sections to Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Frederick county, in regard to automobiles, trucks and other motor vehicles kept at livery, or for which labor, repairs, sundries, oils or gasoline is furnished, and to provide that a claim for the same may be a lien against any automobile, truck and other motor vehicles in Frederick county and be sold at public auction for such claim.” [*Endorsed: “Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays.”*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Kaufman, Bomberger and Warfield.*]

Also House Bill No. 733, entitled “An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 233 of Article 81 of Bagby’s Annotated Code of Maryland, as enacted by the Act of 1914, Chapter 841 (said section being codified in said Code as 234).”
