

be the Treasurer for the said corporation, and shall bond to said corporate body, with security to be approved by the Commissioners or a majority of them, in such penalty as they shall fix, conditioned for the faithful performance of his duty as Treasurer, and he shall receive and pay away monies according to the ordinances passed by said Commissioners or a majority of them.

Section 13. And be it enacted. That said corporation shall not at any time be allowed to issue any note, certificate or other device to be circulated as currency.

Section 14. And be it enacted, That this act shall enure for thirty years, unless sooner repealed by the General Assembly.
