INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

House Bill No. 53—By Delegates Lowe, T. H., Mandel and Harris:

A Bill entitled: An Act to repeal Sections 83(b) and 83(c) of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Elections," subtitle "Presidential Conventions"; and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 85(c) of said Article and subtitle, amending the laws concerning the State and National Conventions held as part of the nominating process for President and Vice President of the United States in order to remove the requirements now binding the delegates thereto to vote for a certain candidate.
