

On motion of Mr. Randall,

The House took up the bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to prevent gaming, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-six, chapter eighty-eight;

Read the second time.

On motion of Mr. Hammond,

The following amendment to the said bill was read and assented to :

Strike out the words "to be" in the fourth line of the first section, and insert the word "as."

The question then recurred on the passage of the said bill as amended;

And on being put, it was passed and sent to the Senate.

The House took up the following bills, entitled to a second reading :

The bill entitled, an act to repeal the act of eighteen hundred and thirty-two, chapter two hundred and thirty;

The bill entitled, an act concerning the abatement of suits;

The bill entitled, an act relating to the approval of trustees bonds and injunction bonds;

Severally read the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

The bill entitled, an act relating to the fees of county surveyors;

Read the second time.

On motion of Mr. Tuck,

The following amendment to said bill was read and assented to :

Add at the end of the first section, "in lieu of all compensation now allowed by law."

Mr. Phelps moved further to amend the said bill by striking out the word "four" in the second line of the first section, and inserting the word "three."

Before the question was put on assenting to the said amendment,

On motion of Mr. Hammond,

Ordered, That the said bill be printed and made the order of the day for Monday next.

The bill entitled, a further supplement to the act to incorporate the Maryland Insurance Company;

And the bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act, passed December session 1841, ch. 284;

Severally read the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.
