The question then recurred on assenting to the amendment submitted by Mr. Semmes, as amended by the motion of Mr. Phelps.

Mr. Key then moved the following as a substitute for the original bill and amendment:

“Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That if all and singular the provisions of this act, shall be accepted by the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, on or before the day of next, at a general meeting of all and singular the stockholders of the said company, to be convened in conformity to the provisions of the act of incorporation of said company, then and from thenceforth, the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company aforesaid, shall be, and is hereby authorised and empowered to create, issue and sell a new, additional and preferred stock of said company, to an amount not exceeding four millions, divided into shares of fifty dollars each, and bearing an interest at a rate not exceeding per centum per annum, payable half yearly on the first day of January and July of every year, out of the tolls and profits of said canal; the said stock to be created, sold and issued upon the terms hereinafter expressed,
