It was determined in the negative.

The following amendment was read and assented to:

Insert after the word "surveys," in the second line of the second section, the words "such record."

The question then recurred on the passage of the said bill,

And on being put, it was passed and sent to the Senate.

And a bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Cecil county to levy a sum of money for paying a balance due William B. Biles and William Mackey;
