

The bill entitled, an act to lessen the annual expenses of Dorchester county ;

Endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendment."

Amendment proposed :

After the word "the," in the third line of the second section, and before the word "clerk," insert the word "sheriff;"

Which was read and assented to.

The bill entitled, an act to regulate the inspection of lumber for the city and county of Baltimore ;

Endorsed "amendments insisted on."

The bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act entitled, an act to authorise the licensing of stock brokers, exchange brokers, and bill brokers, and to regulate the purchase and sale of loans and stocks, passed at December session eighteen hundred and forty-one, chapter two hundred and eighty-two ;

Endorsed "amendments concurred in, agreeably to the report of the committee of conference."

And the resolutions in relation to the tobacco warehouses in the city of Baltimore ;

Endorsed "dissented from."

Mr. Murray reported a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Friendship Lyceum of Friendship, Anne Arundel county ;

Read the first and by special order the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.
