

TO NINE, INCLUSIVE, AND ELEVEN TO SIXTEEN, INCLUSIVE, IN WARD FIFTEEN; AND OF THE AREA WITHIN PRECINCTS EIGHT TO SEVENTEEN, INCLUSIVE, IN WARD SIXTEEN; AND OF THE AREA WITHIN PRECINCTS ONE TO TWELVE, INCLUSIVE, AND WITHIN PRECINCTS SIXTEEN, SEVENTEEN, AND EIGHTEEN, AND WITHIN PRECINCTS TWENTY-ONE TO TWENTY-FIVE, INCLUSIVE, OF WARD NUMBER TWENTY; AND OF THE AREA WITHIN PRECINCTS SEVENTY-EIGHT TO NINETY-FOUR, INCLUSIVE, AND OF PRECINCTS NINETY-EIGHT AND OF PRECINCTS ONE HUNDRED TO ONE HUNDRED FIVE, INCLUSIVE OF WARD NUMBER TWENTY-SEVEN; AND OF THE AREA WITHIN WARD NUMBER TWENTY-EIGHT.

(12) *District 12—Baltimore City, Sixth Legislative District—
2 Senators.*

THE SIXTH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IS COMPOSED OF THE AREA WITHIN WARD EIGHTEEN AND WARD NINETEEN AND OF THE AREA WITHIN PRECINCTS THIRTEEN, FOURTEEN, FIFTEEN, NINETEEN, AND TWENTY IN WARD TWENTY AND OF THE AREA WITHIN WARDS TWENTY-ONE, TWENTY-TWO, TWENTY-THREE, TWENTY-FOUR AND TWENTY-FIVE.

(14) *District 14—Harford County—1 Senator.*

(15) *District 15—Cecil, Kent, Queen Anne's, Caroline and Talbot Counties—2 Senators.*

(16) *District 16—Dorchester, Wicomico, Worcester and Somerset Counties—2 Senators.*

(A-1) ANY SENATORIAL DISTRICT WHICH IS ENTITLED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION TO ELECT MORE THAN TWO SENATORS SHALL BE DIVIDED INTO SUBDISTRICTS. EACH SUBDISTRICT SHALL ELECT A NUMBER OF SENATORS WHICH SHALL BE NOT MORE THAN TWO SENATORS FROM EACH SUBDISTRICT. IF THE SUBDISTRICTING OF ANY SENATORIAL DISTRICT HAS NOT BEEN ACCOMPLISHED BY APRIL 1, 1966 BY ACT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE GOVERNOR OF MARYLAND BY PROCLAMATION SHALL FORTHWITH DETERMINE THE NUMBER AND BOUNDARIES OF THE SUBDISTRICTS, BUT NOT LATER THAN MAY 1, 1966.

(A-2) IN ANY SENATORIAL DISTRICT COMPRISING MORE THAN ONE COUNTY AND HAVING TWO SENATORS, NOT MORE THAN ONE RESIDENT OF ANY ONE COUNTY MAY BE NOMINATED BY ONE POLITICAL PARTY AT THE PRIMARY ELECTION, UNLESS THE POPULATION OF THAT ONE COUNTY EXCEEDS THE POPULATION OF ALL THE REMAINING COUNTIES IN THE DISTRICT IN THE AGGREGATE. PROVIDED THAT ANY SENATORIAL CANDIDATE MUST BE VOTED UPON AT LARGE WITHIN THE ENTIRE DISTRICT AT THE PRIMARY ELECTION. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO GENERAL ELECTIONS FOR THE OFFICE OF STATE SENATOR.
