Amendment No. 5—Strike out all of Amendment No. 1 as adopted on Senate Bill No. 5 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

“Following line 30 of Section 42E on Page 5 of the printed bill, add the following:

(a-1) Any Senatorial District which is entitled under the provisions of this section to elect more than two Senators shall be divided into subdistricts. Each subdistrict shall elect a number of Senators which shall be not more than two Senators from each subdistrict. Notwithstanding the provisions of this subsection if any Senatorial District is entitled to elect more than three Senators, two of the Senators may be nominated by and elected by the voters of the entire Senatorial District. If the subdistricting of any Senatorial District has not been accomplished by April 1, 1966, by act of the General Assembly, the Governor of Maryland by proclamation shall forthwith determine the number and the boundaries of the subdistricts but not later than May 1, 1966.”
