#### AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO.5

By Senators Clark and Hall:

Amendment No. 1—In line 10 of the title of the printed bill immediately following the word "districts" insert the following: "or subdistricts"

Amendment No. 2—Following line 30 of Section 42E on page 5 of the printed bill insert the following:

"Any State Senatorial District having more than one Senator shall be divided into a number of subdistricts equal to the number of Senators in that District. The subdistricts in any District shall be of compact and contiguous territory with a substantial equality in population, and the boundaries of the subdistricts shall be as established from time to time by a law enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. Each Senator in the District shall be a resident in and representative of one of the subdistricts, and a person appointed to fill a vacancy in an office of Senator shall be a resident of that subdistrict in which the vacancy occurred."
