AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL NO.5

By Senator H. Hughes :

Following line 30 of Section 42E on page 5 of the printed bill, insert the following new paragraph :

“(a-2) In any Senatorial District comprising more than one county and having two Senators, not more than one resident of any one county may be nominated by one political party at the primary election, unless the population of that one county exceeds the population of all the remaining counties in the District in the aggregate. Provided that any Senatorial candidate must be voted upon at large within the entire District at the primary election. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to General elections for the office of State Senator.”

Which was read and adopted.

Senator Mach then offered the following amendment from the floor.

AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL NO. 5

By Senators Mach and Hodges :

In Line 14 of Section 42E on Page 4 of the printed bill, after the following: “2 Senators.” add the following :

“For the purposes of this section the First Legislative District composed of the area within Wards One, Two, Three, Four, and Five; and within the area of Precincts Seven to Fourteen, inclusive, in Ward Number Six; and of the area within Precincts One, Two, Three, and Twenty-three, Twenty-four, and Twenty-five of Ward Sixteen; and of the area within Ward Seventeen; and of the area within the Precincts One to Twenty-nine, inclusive, of Ward Number Twenty-six which are situated southeasterly from the center line of Sinclair Lane; and of the area within Precinct Thirty-nine of the Twenty-sixth Ward.”;

and in Line 16 after the following: “2 Senators.” add the following :

“For the purpose of this section the Second Legislative District is composed of the area within Precincts One to Six, inclusive, of
