AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 7

By Senator Clark from the floor:

Amendment No. 2—In line 10 of the title of the printed bill immediately following the word “districts” insert the following: “and subdistricts”

Amendment No. 3—In line 4 of Section 42E on page 4 of the printed bill strike out the word “seventeen” and insert in lieu thereof the word “sixteen.”

Amendment No. 4—In line 6 of Section 42E on page 4 of the printed bill, strike out the word “and” immediately preceding the word “Frederick” and following the word “Frederick” add the following: “, and Carroll”

Amendment No. 5—In line 7 of Section 42E on page 4 of the printed bill, strike out the numeral 3 and insert in lieu thereof the numeral 4.

Amendment No. 6—Strike out all of line 8 of Section 42E on page 4 of the printed bill.

Amendment No. 7—Strike out all of line 9 of Section 42E on page 4 of the printed bill and insert in lieu thereof the following: “(2) District 2—Howard and Montgomery Counties—5 Senators.”

Amendment No. 8—In lines 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 17, 19, 21, 23, 25, 26, 27, 29, and 32 of Section 42E on pages 4 and 5 of the printed bill, strike out in both instances in each line respectively the following numerals: “(4)” and “4”, “(5)” and “5”, “(6)” and “6”, “(7)” and “7”, “(8)” and “8”, “(9)” and “9”, “(10)” and “10”, “(11)” and “11”, “(12)” and “12”, “(13)” and “13”, “(14)” and “14”, “(15)” and “15”, “(16)” and “16”, and “(17)” and “17” and insert in lieu thereof in both instances in each respective line the following numerals: “(3)” and “3”, “(4)” and “4”, “(5)” and “5”, “(6)” and “6”, “(7)” and “7”, “(8)” and “8”, “(9)” and “9”, “(10)” and “10”, “(11)” and “11”, “(12)” and “12”, “(13)” and “13”, “(14)” and “14”, “(15)” and “15”, and “(16)” and “16”.

Amendment No. 9—Following line 33 of Section 42E on page 5 of the printed bill, insert the following new paragraph:

“Any State Senatorial District having more than one Senator shall be divided into a number of subdistricts equal to the number of Senators in that District. The subdistricts in any District shall be of compact and contiguous territory with a substantial equality in population, and the boundaries of the subdistricts shall be as established from time to time by a law enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. Each Senator in the District shall be a resident in and representative of one of the subdistricts, and a person appointed to fill a vacancy in an office of Senator shall be a resident of that subdistrict in which the vacancy occurred.”

Amendment No. 10—In lines 12, 13, and 16 of subsection (c) on page 5 of the printed bill immediately following the word “District” in each instance insert the following: “or subdistrict”
