SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 18 of Article II of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1965 Supplement), title "Banks and Trust Companies," subtitle "Bank Commissioner," and Sections 75 and 108F of said Article and title, subtitle "General Regulations," be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

If in the judgment of the Commissioner any banking institution operating under the provisions of this article or any other law, and or any of its directors, officers, trustees, managers, agents, clerks or employees, has violated any of the provisions of this article or any other law pertaining to such an institution, he shall forthwith report such violation to the Governor of the State, who shall direct the Attorney General to institute a proper proceeding for the prosecution of such violation.

Such violation shall be a [misdemeanor] *felony* and if the accused shall be found guilty he shall be fined not more than three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) or be imprisoned for not more than five (5) years or both.
