Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3

Offered from the floor by Delegate McGuirk:

Amendment No. 1—In lines 6 and 7 of the title of the third reading file bill, strike out beginning with the words “for the” in line 6 down to and including the word “Act” in line 7.

Which was read.

Amendment No. 2—In lines 4 and 5 of Section 166B on page 1 of the third reading file bill, strike out beginning with the words “at the” in line 4 down to and including the word “only” in line 5.

Which was read.

Amendment No. 3—Strike out all of lines 1-9, inclusive, comprising all of Section 2 on page 2 of the third reading file bill.

Which was read.

Amendment No. 4—In line 1 of Section 3 on page 2 of the third reading file bill, strike out the numeral “3” and insert in lieu thereof the numeral “2.”

Which was read.

Mr. McGuirk, moved to lay over the bill and amendments under the rule for one day.
