Amendment No. 1—In line 22 of subsection (b) on page 2 of the third reading file bill, following the period add the following: "In levying and imposing a tax upon nonresidents, under the provisions of this section, a county or Baltimore City shall not levy and impose a tax upon the wages and salaries of nonresidents who are not physically within the county or City at the time of earning the wages or salaries, even if the payment of the wages and salaries is made from the county or City."
