So the bill was rejected.

Mr. Edward A. Lynch submitted the following resolutions:

Resolved by the House of Delegates, That it is impracticable to transact the business of the present session, within the time limited by the constitution, with due regard to the momentous interests confided to us; therefore be it further

Resolved, That the Honorable the Speaker of this house, transmit a copy of these resolutions to his Excellency the Governor, respectfully requesting him to exercise such powers as may be vested in the Executive, to re-convene this legislature at the earliest convenient day.

Which were twice read, and assented to.

Mr. Gaither, from the committee on corporations, reported a bill, entitled an act to incorporate the Mutual Fire Insurance Company of Cecil county;

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled a supplement to an act, entitled an act to establish a uniform system of charges by notaries public in this state, passed at the present session, ch. 92, so far as the same extends to Talbot county;

Also the bill, entitled an act to make public a road therein mentioned;

Also the bill, entitled an act to change the names of John Woolford and Susan, his wife, and James Woolford, Josiah Woolford, Harriet Woolford, and Susan Emily Woolford, his children, of Dorchester county, to that of John Keene, Susan Keene, James Keene, Josiah Keene, Harriet Keene, and Susan Emily Keene;

Also the bill, entitled an act to incorporate the Franklin Beneficial Total Abstinence Society of Fell's Point;

Also the bill, entitled an act further to extend the time allowed Thomas M. D. Baden, collector of taxes of Prince George's county, to complete his collections;

Also the bill, entitled an act relating to the city of Baltimore;

Severally endorsed "will pass," and severally ordered to be engrossed;

Also returned the bill, entitled an act authorising the correction of an error in a patent therein mentioned;

Also a bill, entitled an additional supplement to the act, entitled an act for the despatch of business in Baltimore county court, passed December session 1828, ch. 161, severally endorsed "will not pass;"

Also, the bill, entitled an act for the benefit of Lewis N. Sewell, collector of taxes for the city of Annapolis and collector of taxes for the fourth collection district of Anne Arundel county;
