

On the question being put, will the house reconsider their vote; it was

Determined in the negative.

The Speaker announced that the hour had arrived for taking up the order of the day.

The house then proceeded to consider the order of the day, being the bill reported by Mr. Bowie, entitled an act to authorise the incorporated banks of this State, to issue small notes for a limited time;

Mr. Bowie moved that said bill be referred to the committee on ways and means;

Mr. Tuck moved to amend said motion, by adding thereto the following instructions:

With instructions to inquire into the expediency of providing for the transfer of all the State stock issued for the benefit of the several internal improvement companies of this State (and not already sold or disposed) to commissioners; with authority in the said companies to draw, and in the said commissioners to accept drafts to an amount not exceeding a certain per cent. on the whole amount of unsold stock issued for their benefit respectively; and in denominations of not less than one dollar, to be funded when presented in sums of one hundred dollars—and authorising the incorporated banks in this State to receive and pay out such stock order, as currency, and imposing on the said companies, as a condition upon which said issues shall be made, the payment of the full amount due by them respectively to the Treasury; and extending said privilege only to those of said companies which shall have so discharged their liabilities to the Treasury; and report by bill or otherwise;

Resolved in the affirmative.

The question then recurred and was put upon the motion of Mr. Bowie as amended by the motion of Mr. Tuck, and

Resolved in the affirmative.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled an act to authorise the removal of certain cases to the court of Howard District of Anne Arundel county:

Endorsed "will pass," and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the resolution in favor of Ann Cadle,

Endorsed "assented to," and the resolution ordered to be engrossed.

And delivered the following bills originated in and passed by the senate, viz

A bill, entitled an act to repeal an act, entitled an act to change the place of holding the election in the fifth election district in Cecil county;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Morton, Simcoe and Maxwell.

A bill, entitled an act to confirm an act, entitled an act to alter and amend the constitution so far as it relates to the power of the Legislature to grant Lotteries, passed at December session 1839, chapter 31;
