

Mr. Edes presented the memorial of the grand jury of Kent county, praying the passage of an act making it a penitentiary offence for any body of men to conspire together to issue paper, purporting to be money;

Which was read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

And Mr. Orrell presented the petition of 95 citizens of Caroline county, praying a repeal of the act which prohibits the return of free people of color to this state, so far as relates to said county;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Orrell, Nicols and Sullivan.

Mr. Le Grand obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled an act to change the name of Benedict Arnold, of the city of Baltimore, to George William Arnold;

Ordered, That Messrs. Le Grand, Graves and Presstman report the same.

On motion of Mr. Presstman,

Leave was granted the committee on corporations to bring in a bill to be entitled an act supplementary to an act to incorporate the Patapsco Insurance Company;

On motion of Mr. Presstman,

Leave was granted the committee on grievances and courts of justice to bring in a bill relating to transferred judgments in the city of Baltimore.

Mr. Tuck obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled a supplement to the act passed December session 1839, entitled an act to change the investment of the school fund of Prince George's county;

Ordered, That Messrs. Tuck, Bowie and Maccubbin report the same.

Mr. Forman obtained leave to bring in a bill to repeal the act relating to the people of color in this state, passed March 12, 1832, ch. 281;

Ordered, That Messrs. Forman, Brent and Lecompte report the same.

Mr. Matthews obtained leave to bring in a bill, to be entitled a supplement to an act, entitled an act to regulate the inspection of tobacco;

Ordered, That Messrs. Matthews, Brent and Bowling report the same.

Mr. Paca obtained leave to bring in a bill authorising William B. Paca to build a bridge across the branch of Wye river, known as Back Wye;

Ordered, That Messrs. Paca, Ford and George report the same.

Mr. Maxwell obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled an act to authorise the Governor to appoint an inspector of flour in Port Deposit, in Cecil county;

Ordered, That Messrs. Maxwell, Morton and Simcoe report the same.
