The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The message proposing an interchange of services between the Rev. Mr. Furlong, and the Rev. Mr. Winslow,

Was sent to the senate.

The speaker laid before the house the following communication:  
*To the Honorable*

*The Speaker of the House of Delegates :*

Sir: In obedience to the sixth rule of the house, I have the honor herewith to report the following bills, having been referred by the last to the present house of delegates.—To wit:

A bill entitled an act to abolish Magistrate's Courts within this State, and to extend the jurisdiction of single Justices of the Peace in certain cases.

A bill entitled a supplement to an act entitled "an act to repair injuries done by rail road carriages and engines upon the several rail roads of this State, passed December session 1838, chapter 244.

A bill entitled an act supplementary to an act entitled an act for the prevention of frauds on the right of voting by the stockholders in the several incorporated institutions of this State, passed at December session 1836, chapter 264.

A bill entitled an act to provide for the re-organization of the city court of Baltimore, and for the more prompt administration of justice in said city.

A bill entitled an act providing for the repeal of the fifty-ninth article of the constitution.

A bill entitled an act for the better regulation of the banking institutions of this State.

A bill entitled an act for the relief of lunatic paupers.

A bill entitled an act to provide for the appointment of an agricultural chemist for the State of Maryland.

A bill entitled an act to incorporate the Havre de Grace Bank.

A bill entitled, an act to raise revenue for the support of Government.

A bill entitled an act to lay out and construct a road from Eldersburg in Carroll county or some point near Eldersburg, to Reisterstown, and from thence to a point at or near St. John's Church on the Dover road in Baltimore county.

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Tobacco Planters' Bank of Maryland.

A bill entitled an act for the better regulation of the Banking institutions of this State.

A bill entitled an act to alter and amend the constitution, so far as relates to the loaning of the public money or credit to corporations.

A bill entitled a further additional supplement to the act entitled an act for the relief of sundry insolvent debtors.
