The house was again called, and the door-keeper sent for the absent members, who, after a short time, returned and reported, that he had again notified them that their attendance in the house was required.

At half past 12 o'clock,

The house was called, and the door-keeper sent for the absent members, who, after a short time, returned and again reported that he had notified them that their attendance in the house was required.
