Mr. Smith presented the petition of Peter Preston and fifty-three other citizens of Allegany county, praying that lumber haulers on the the national road, may be put on an equality with the coal haulers, so far as toll is concerned, and that the superintendent of said road be elected by the people;

Which was read and referred to the Allegany county delegation.

Mr. Poultney presented the petition of William and Mary Tyson of Baltimore county, praying to be placed on the pension list of said county;

Which was read and referred to the Baltimore county delegation.

Mr. Stephenson presented the petition of fifty one citizens of Harford county, counter to the application of the Baltimore and Harford Turnpike Company, to be released from the obligation of extending their road;

Which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.

Mr. Carey presented the memorial of William Howell and sons, and others, praying the incorporation of a new mutual insurance company in the city of Baltimore;

Also, presented the memorial of the President and Directors of the Baltimore and Chesapeake Steam Towing Company, praying an extension of the charter of said company;

Which were severally read and referred to the committee on Corporations.
