

for the general revenue of the State, and that the said Treasurer be authorised to pay for said publication out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury ;

Which was read the first and by a special order the second time, assented to, and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Temples from the select committee, to which was referred the petition of Thomas Bostich, Samuel Moore and Henrietta Fields of Queen Anne's county, reported that said committee had had the same under consideration, and were of opinion that the trustees of the poor of said county, had power to grant them the relief prayed for and therefore asked to be discharged from the further consideration thereof ;

Which was twice read and concurred in.

Mr. Semmes chairman of the select committee, to which was referred the bill from the senate entitled, an act to enable Robert H. Lanham, former collector of Prince George's county, to complete his collections, reported the same with the following amendment :

Amendment proposed :

Strike out the proviso, at the end of the 1st section ;

The said bill was then read the first and by a special order the second time, passed with the proposed amendment, and the bill returned to the Senate.

On motion of Mr. Yellott,

Leave was granted the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, to bring in a bill to repeal the act passed at December session eighteen hundred and forty-two, chapter one hundred and seventy-four, relating to the Tide Water Canal.

The clerk of the Senate returned a bill entitled, an act for the relief of William W. Hooff ;

Also, a bill entitled, an act for the benefit of the securities of Frederick Wilson, former Register of Wills for Kent county ;

Also a bill entitled, an act to regulate the height of fences in the sixth election district in Allegany county ;

Also, a bill entitled, an act to authorise William O. Chappell, acting administrator of Henry Lilly, late sheriff and collector of Montgomery county, to complete his collections ;

Also, a bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the town of Havre de Grace ;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to preserve the fish in the waters of the Chesapeake bay, and for other purposes ;

Also, the bill entitled, an act authorising a certain portion of the school funds belonging to Caroline and Dorchester counties to be applied for the benefit of a school at Midway school house in Caroline county, near the line between said county and Dorchester ;

Also, the bill entitled, an act for the benefit of Lemuel Dunbracco, collector of the State taxes in Queen Anne's county for the year 1842 ;

Also, the bill entitled, a further supplement to the act author.
