Endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments ;"

Which amendments were twice read, assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

Severally endorsed, "assented to," and the resolutions ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the bill entitled, an act to give further time to Hugh C. Whiteford, collector of State and county taxes for the fifth election district of Harford county, to complete his collections ;
