

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION—Leave granted the committee on Ways and Means to report a bill to create a State, for the purpose of equalizing the value of property, embraced in the act of the general assessment and valuation of property in this State, passed at March session 1841, chapter 23, 65; bill reported and ordered to be printed 87; made the order of the day for 31st January 144; taken up, amendment proposed, and its consideration postponed till the 14th February 216; taken up and recommitted 432; taken up and a motion made to strike out the enacting clause of the bill 455; negatively 457; amendments proposed 455; and adopted 458; referred to the consideration of the next General Assembly 458.
