Resolutions proposed to suspend the, of the State taxes until the amounts of money due from the several clerks and sheriffs of this State, shall have been collected by due process of law, if necessary and paid into the public treasury 212; and until this or a subsequent legislature shall have provided an efficient system of taxation as shall be fully sufficient to pay the interest on the State debt, and thus provide for the maintainance of the honor and faith of the State 213; referred to the committee on ways and means 286.
