- CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS**—Leave to report a bill to divide the State into six, 21; referred a committee of one from each county and the city of Baltimore *ib*, bill reported 55; made the order of the day for 10th January 56; motion to take up negatived 78; the bill considered 87, 88; amendments proposed and a motion to postpone and print, negatived, 94, 95; motion to recommit with instructions proposed 95; negatived 96; the bill passed *ib*, sent to the senate 97; returned passed 108.  
 Noted that the minority of the committee appointed to divide the State into six, dissent from the report of the majority, and will submit a counter report 56.  
 The minority report a counter bill which is ordered to be printed 72; the bill from the minority of the committee rejected 88.  
 Noted that the names of Messrs. Dale, Stewart and Thomas of Talbot, should have appeared in the negative on the final passage of the bill dividing the State into, 121.
- CONJUGAL RIGHTS**—Leave granted to report a bill supplemental to the act to regulate, passed December session 1842, chapter 293, 84.  
 A supplement to the act regulating, as respects property received from the senate and referred 391; favorable report thereon 427; laid on the table 428; taken up and rejected 532.
