Also, the bill entitled, an act for the relief of the heirs of the late William Brown, of Carroll county ;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to make valid a certain deed therein named ;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to change the place of holding elections in the third election district of Howard District, and to alter the bounds thereof ;

And, the bill entitled, an act to allow Edward Collinson, further time to complete his collections ;

Severally endorsed, "will pass," and the bills severally ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the trustees of the Evangelical Lutheran Congregation of Taneytown Carroll county ;

Endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendment,"

Which amendment was read the first and by a special order the second time, "assented to," and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the resolution in favor of Mrs. Amelia Pinkney ;

And, the preamble and resolution in relation to the harbor of Havre De Grace ;

Severally endorsed, "assented to," and the resolutions ordered to be engrossed.

Also, returned the resolution relative to the disposal of certain furniture in the government house ;

Endorsed, "amendment dissented from, and resolution ordered to be returned to the House of Delegates for reconsideration ;"

Which was read and ordered to lie on the table.
