The House met.

The clerk of the Senate returned the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act in aid of the Susquehanna canal company, and of the Tide Water canal company, passed at December session 1843, ch. 363;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of the tax of Baltimore and Carroll counties, to build a bridge over the Patapsco Falls, on the Marriottsville road;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to establish a primary school at Schafersville in Howard District;

Also, the bill entitled, an act for the benefit of the trustees of the primary schools of St. Mary's county;
