

The County may, by appropriate resolution, provide for the replacement of any bonds issued hereunder which shall have become mutilated or be destroyed or lost upon such conditions and after receiving such indemnity as the County may think it proper and necessary to stipulate and require.

SEC. 8. *And be it further enacted*, That any and all obligations issued pursuant to the authority of this Act, their transfer and the income therefrom (including any profit made on the sale thereof) shall at all times be free from taxation by the State of Maryland or by any of its political subdivisions, or by any town or incorporated municipality or by any other public agency within the State of Maryland.

SEC. 9. *And be it further enacted*, That the authority to borrow money and issue bonds conferred on the County by this Act shall be deemed to provide an additional and alternative authority for borrowing money and shall be regarded as supplemental and additional to powers conferred upon the County by other laws and shall not be regarded as in derogation of any power now existing; and all Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland heretofore passed authorizing the County to borrow money are hereby continued to the extent that the powers contained in such acts have not heretofore been exercised, and nothing herein contained shall be construed to impair, in any way whatsoever, the validity of any bonds which may have been issued by the County under the authority of any of said Acts, and the validity of said bonds is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

SEC. 10. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1969.

CHAPTER 460  
(Senate Bill 569)

AN ACT to authorize the Board of Public Works to acquire by gift, purchase or condemnation, any statute to the contrary notwithstanding, certain land and improvements located in or near the City of Annapolis necessary to complete the development of the development plan generally referred to as the "Maryland State Facilities in Annapolis", and to authorize the Board of Public Works to enter into agreement with the State Roads Commission and any other public or private agency, group or individual to facilitate and complete such development of the Maryland State Facilities in Annapolis, and to repeal Chapter 697 of the Acts of 1967.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Board of Public Works is authorized to acquire by purchase, gift or condemnation, in whole or in part, the properties and improvements thereon, and described herein, within and without the City
