

TO BE UNDER THE NEW SUBTITLE "THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES"; and to repeal Sections 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33 and 34 of Article 15A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition, 1968 Replacement Volume and 1969 Supplement), title "Budget and Fiscal Planning," subtitles "Purchasing Bureau" and "Purchases"; and to repeal Sections 30, 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 of Article 91 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1969 Replacement Volume), title "Surveyor and State Survey," subtitle "Maryland Coordinate System" SUBHEADING "BUREAU OF CONTROL SURVEYS AND MAPS"; and to repeal Sections 18, 19 and 24 of Article 78A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1969 Replacement Volume) title "Public Works," subtitle "Department of Public Improvements"; and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 17, 19A, 20, 21, 22, 23 and 25 of Article 78A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1969 Replacement Volume) title "Public Works," subtitle "Department of Public Improvements," said sections to be under the same title, but to be under the new subtitle "Department of General Services"; AND TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT, WITH AMENDMENTS, SECTION 52 OF ARTICLE 78A OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND (1957 EDITION, 1969 REPLACEMENT VOLUME), TITLE "PUBLIC WORKS," SUBTITLE "ARTISTIC PROPERTY"; and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 133, 134, 135, 136, 137 and 138 of Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition, 1965 Replacement Volume and 1969 Supplement) title "Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments," ~~subtitles~~ SUBTITLE "The Executive Department," SUBHEADING "Superintendent of Buildings"; and to ~~enact~~ ~~new Section 139A~~ ADD NEW SECTION 140 to Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition, 1965 Replacement Volume and 1969 Supplement), title "Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments," ~~subtitles~~ SUBTITLE "The Executive Department," SUBHEADING "Superintendent of Buildings," to follow immediately after Section 139 thereof; and repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 1 of Article 54 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition, 1968 Replacement Volume and 1969 Supplement) title "Hall of Records," subtitle "Hall of Records Commission"; and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 78 of Article 65 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition, 1968 Replacement Volume and 1969 Supplement), title "Militia," subtitle "War Memorial Commission"; and to repeal and re-enact, WITH AMENDMENTS, Sections 3 and 6 of Chapter 213 of the Laws of Maryland, 1870, to create in the Executive Branch of Maryland Government a Department of General Services to be headed by the Secretary of General Services, and to provide for the duties and responsibilities of said Secretary as well as the staffing of said Department, to provide that said Secretary shall be responsible for the operation of the Department of General Services and requiring the Secretary to establish guidelines and procedures to promote the orderly and efficient administration thereof, and to provide that said Secretary be responsible for carrying out the Governor's policies with respect to all matters assigned to said Department; to provide for the appointment of a Deputy Secretary and such office assistants, professional consultants and employees as may be provided by law or the State Budget; to provide that the Attorney General be the legal adviser
