

drawn from Drum Point in Calvert County to Hog Point in St. Mary's County, crabbing with a trotline is prohibited by any except bona fide residents of the counties bordering on the Patuxent River. No person sixty-four years of age or older or less than fourteen years of age shall be required to pay the license fee specified in this section.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1970.

CHAPTER 377

(House Bill 1337)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 18-1(a) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County (1963 Edition), being Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Prince George's County," subtitle "County Commissioners," providing for the appointment of and the duties of an Administrative Officer to the Prince George's County Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 18-1(a) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County (1963 Edition), being Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Prince George's County," subtitle "County Commissioners," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

18-1.

(a) Numbers, officers, compensation. There shall be five county commissioners for Prince George's County, elected for a term of four years, and they shall be known by the corporate style of "County Commissioners for Prince George's County," hereinafter referred to as the board. The said board shall elect a presiding officer to serve during his term of office and shall devote his full time to the duties of his office and he shall not engage in any business or profession, for earned income, during his term of office as such presiding officer; he shall have, subject to the direction of and review by the Board, administrative supervision over all departments and employees of the County government. Until December 4, 1962, the presiding officer shall receive an annual salary of seven thousand and five hundred dollars and each of the other four commissioners shall receive an annual salary of three thousand six hundred dollars, as full compensation for their official duties as commissioner or in any ex officio capacity; and, after December 4, 1962, the presiding officer shall receive an annual salary of twelve thousand five hundred dollars (\$12,500.00), and the vice chairman shall receive an annual salary of seven thousand (\$7,000.00) dollars and each of the other three commissioners shall receive an annual salary of six thousand five hundred (\$6,500.) dollars, as full compensation for their official duties as commissioner or in any ex officio capacity but shall not be entitled to receive any further or other allowance or expense money.
