In accordance with Article II, Section 17, of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1272.

This bill amends the law relating to carnivals, bazaars and raffles conducted by certain non-profit or charitable organizations.

House Bill 1272 was sponsored by the Charles County Delegation to the General Assembly. Since the adjournment of the General Assembly, the Charles County Delegation has written to me requesting that the bill be vetoed. A copy of the Delegation's letter is attached herewith, and is to be considered part of this message. Consequently, I am vetoing House Bill 1272 at the request of the sponsors.
